- 5. Any other specifics about the building you want us to know about.

Use the butcher paper and markers to "build" and get creative!

- Groups of 3 or 4 will get poster board (butcher paper) and makers to design their own hall.
- Students should keep in mind what makes a community and the logistics
- Goals- work together, creativity, understand and build community
